## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

**Part 1: Honors Coursework** (complete 12 s.h. by the end of your 4th full semester in the program.)

- Take an honors class during your first full semester in the program.
- Meet with an honors peer mentor once per year until you have completed 12 s.h. honors coursework.

**Part 2: Experiential Learning** (earn 12 honors credits by graduation.)

- Can be done through one or more experiences.

Honors section of a regular class (see MyUI for offerings)	Variable R
<b>Honors Contract Course:</b> A regular class contracted for honors credit <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Work with instructor to complete an individual, course-related project</li><li>• See <a href="#">Honors Contract</a>. Honors credit will be awarded for two contracts per student (for exceptions, contact <a href="mailto:honors-advisor@uiowa.edu">honors-advisor@uiowa.edu</a>).</li></ul>	Variable R

Experiences followed by an R can be repeated for additional credit towards University Honors, see listing on MyUI for details and restrictions.

## EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING OPTIONS\* (MINIMUM 12 HONORS CREDITS)

\*Honors Reflection Process (required by most experiences in order to earn credit) consists of:

- Pre-experience questionnaire, post-experience questionnaire, narrative reflection

<b>Mentored Research</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Undergraduate Research Experiences (URES:3992, URES:3993, URES:3994)*<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ 1-4 credits per semester</li></ul></li><li>• ICRU Research Fellow (URES:3995)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Variable credit per semester, based on hours</li></ul></li><li>• Honors Research Practicum (HONR:3994)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ 1-3 credits per semester</li></ul></li></ul>	Up to 12 credits; limit 4 per semester/term
Complete <a href="#">Honors Reflection Process</a> for credit if research is paid, volunteer, or registered for 0 semester hours.	
<b>Honors Writing Fellowship</b> (HONR:3220) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Serve as a Writing Fellow (paid position, peer tutors are paired with select courses)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Application required; see <a href="#">Honors Writing Fellows</a></li></ul></li></ul>	Up to 12 credits

### **Study Abroad** (complete Honors Reflection Process)

- 1-2 week experience: 1 credit
- 3-5 week experience: up to 2 credits
- 6-9 week experience: up to 3 credits
- 10+ week experience: up to 4 credits

Up to 12 credits

For experiences lasting 6 or more weeks, add up to **3 additional credits** for completion of an **optional independent project**.

### **Internship** (complete Honors Reflection Process)

- For **zero-credit internships**, credit amounts are same as for Study Abroad (above)
- For **credit-bearing** internships/practicums, honors credit mirrors amount of registered semester hours (eg. 1-sh course equals 1 honors credit)
- **Register through** HONR:3160 Honors Internship, CCP:XXXX, or a departmental internship course. Tippie students should enroll in BUS:3100.
- Teaching/Learning Assistantship (HONR: 3100)
